permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada,
as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation give date and

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is James White Spring
at or near Cors. Com. Secs 1-6-7 and 12 Tp.24 N.rgs 53 and 55 of
M.D.M. of stream, or other source.

2. The amount of water applied for is all or up to 1 second-feet.
One second-foot equals 40 miners' inches.

3. The water to be used for stock and irrigation of small garden
near or at the spring
Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic, or other use.

4. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following
point: Within 50 to 100' of the Cor. Com to secs 1-6-7 and 12 Tp
24 N.R.53 and 53 E. M.D.M. the spring to be developed and pump
erected alongside to obtain some water for D.L.C. if that be poss-
ible this can only be shown on final proof map.

A substantial headgate and weir must be installed at or near the point of diversion to facilitate the measurement and control of water. The

State reserves the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times. It is distinctly understood that applicant agrees to the terms herein contained.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed One cubic foot per second.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before July 28, 1921

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before August 28, 1921

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before July 28, 1922

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before August 28, 1922

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before September 28, 1927

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use must be filed with State Engineer on or before October 28, 1927
