permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada,

4. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following  
point: From the Large Artesian Well, situate N.W. $\frac{1}{4}$  of the N.E. $\frac{1}{4}$  of

## SUPPLEMENTAL SHEET.

Said Farm consisting of three Tracts, One, Two and Three respectively Fully description of Land Irrigated and upon which stock is watered, and the house stands where water is used for domestic Use.

Three certain tracts situate in Section Four (4), in Township, Twenty-One (21), South, of Range Sixty-one (61) East, Mount Diablo Base and Meridian, containing about Twenty-Nine (29) or Thirty (30) Acres, more or less according to the survey thereof.

Said tracts are more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

Tract One Beginning at a corner or point 660 Feet south of the North End Center of said Section Four (4); Thence east 660 feet; Thence South 660 Feet; Thence West 660 Feet; Thence North 660 feet to the place of beginning.

Tract No. Two beginning at a point 660 Feet south of the North end center of said Section Four (4) Thence west 745 Feet; Thence South 660 Feet; Thence East 745 Feet; Thence North 660 to the place of beginning.

Tract No Three beginning at a point on the west line of the Right of way of the Los Angeles and Salt Lake Railroad, said point being 307-8/10 feet, South 28 Degrees and 13' west from the intersection of said Right of Way with the North Line of said Section Four and running west 905.8 Feet; Thence South 450. feet; Thence East 697.4; Thence 490 feet North along the west line of said Right of Way to the place of beginning. All in Section Four (4) Township Twenty-One (21), South, Range Sixty-One (61) East, Mount Diablo Base and Meridian, in the County of Clark, State of Nevada.

The Large Artesian Well, which furnishes nearly all of the Water is Situate on the Tract described Number One; and said Tract is in North West One Fourth ( $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of the North East One Fourth ( $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section Four, In township Twenty One (21) South, Range Sixty One (61) East Mount Diablo Base and meridian.

The Small Artesian Well is situate on the Tract Numbered Two as above described, and said tract is situate in the North East One Fourth ( $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of the North West One Fourth ( $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of said Section Four (4), in Township Twenty One (21), South of Range Sixty-One (61), East, Mount Diablo Base and Meridian. all in Clark County, State of Nevada.

All of the Land described in the above named tracts are irrigated by the Water from the above described Wells.

It all of the water that those wells furnish to properly Irrigate the said 29 to 30 acres of Land, and water Stock, and for domestic use in the House.
