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The undersigned, FRANK C. STRANGE, of Halleck, Elko County, Nevada, hereby makes application to change the place of use of waters heretofore appropriated and beneficially used by himself and his predecessors under application to and permission from the State Engineer of the State of Nevada as hereinafter shown.

The source of the water supply proposed to be changed is Lamoille Creek.

The quantity of water desired to be changed is three-tenths (.3) cubic feet per second.

The water is to be used for irrigation.

The water is to be diverted from its source at the same point as the present diversion from Lamoille Creek, to-wit: on the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec.33, T.34 N.R.58 E., M.D.M.

The water hereby desired to be changed has been beneficially and continuously used upon the following described lands, to-wit: 30 acres of land in the west half of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec.16 of said Township and Range.

The number of acres heretofore irrigated is thirty (30).

The number of acres proposed to be irrigated is thirty (30).

The description of the land proposed to be irrigated is as follows: 30 acres of land in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ and the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec.9 in said township and range.

Description of proposed works, dams, ditches and laterals.

Estimated cost of proposed works is \$200.00.

Estimated time required to construct the works is one year.

Irrigation will begin about April 1st of each year and end about October 15th of each year depending on the season.

The water has been used heretofore approximately from April 1st to October 15th of each year for irrigation purposes on the said 30 acres in said west half of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Sec.16.

REMARKS: Accompanying this application for change of place of use applicant files his map showing his proposed diversion, ditches, etc., and showing the original land upon which the water was used and the land upon which it is proposed to be used.

The conveying of said water to the proposed place of use, although by means of the original diversion from Lamoille Creek through the Rockwell-Plaza Ditch, is made directly from said ditch at a point approximately two miles north of said main diversion and is to be conveyed from the point of diversion from said Rockwell-Plaza Ditch across Sec.16 to the lands of applicant as indicated upon the accompanying map.

The NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Sec.16, which said proposed ditch will traverse, is owned by M.M.Rockwell and the west half of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Sec.16, which said proposed ditch will traverse, is owned by Emeterio Plaza, Conveyance by said parties to applicant of a perpetual easement and right of way for said proposed ditch accompanies this application and is filed herewith. The said Rockwell and Plaza are the only persons who could be adversely effected by the proposed change in place of use and both of said persons in their said granting of such easement and right of way specifically give their consent to the granting of this application.

The original application to the State Engineer, under which this right and permit arise, is No.2783 in the State Engineer's files and was made by Oscar J.Streeter and M.M.Rockwell, which said application bears the endorsements of the State Engineer's office, showing the filing of map thereunder and the filing of proof of labor and proof of completion of work with provision that water be applied to beneficial use on or before June 15, 1921, and that proof of such application to beneficial use must be filed on or before July 15, 1921.

Assignment from Oscar J. Streeter and Frank C. Strange, covering that portion of the lands and water involved in the premises, was filed in the office of the State Engineer, December 31, 1920.

WHEREFORE applicant prays that this application for change of place of use be duly filed and acted upon in the manner provided by law and that the time for performance of any of the conditions under application No. 2783 yet to be performed be extended for a reasonable period to the end that the performance of such conditions may be had and done upon the said new lands upon which the said water is proposed to be used.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the place of use of 0.3 cubic foot per second for 30 acres in the W-SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 16, T. 34 N., R. 58 E., to 30 acres in the SE-NE $\frac{1}{4}$ and NE-SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 9, T. 34 N., R. 58 E., being a portion of the water right granted under permit No. 2783, is issued with the same conditions originally imposed in said permit No. 2783. The State reserves the right to regulate the use of the water under this proposed change at any and all times.

The amount of water to be changed shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use and not to exceed 0.3 cubic foot per second.

Actual construction of work shall begin on or before June 19, 1922. Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before July 19, 1922. Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before June 19, 1923.

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before July 19, 1923. Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before November 19, 1924.

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use must be filed with State Engineer on or before December 19, 1924.
