DIVERSION, AND PLACE OF USE OF THE WATERS  
OF THE STATE OF NEVADA HERETOFORE  
GRANTED UNDER PERMIT NO. 2306.

The undersigned Ethel S. Henrie, of Elgin, County of Lincoln, State of Nevada, hereby makes application to change the point of diversion, and place of use of the waters of Meadow Valley Wash Creek, heretofore appropriated under application and permit No. 2306.

1. The source of the water supply proposed to be changed is Meadow Valley Wash Creek.
2. The quantity of water desired to be changed is 400 acre feet per annum, or one cubic foot per second.
3. The water is to be used for Irrigation and domestic purposes.
4. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point: NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Sec. 35, T. 7 S., R. 67 E., M. D. B. & M..
5. The existing point of diversion under the former appropriation is as follows: SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Sec. 22, T. 8 S., R. 67 E., M. D. B. & M..
6. The water, herewith desired to be changed, was proposed to be beneficially and continuously used upon the following described lands: NW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Sec. 11, T. 8 S., R. 67 E., M. D. B. & M..
7. Number of acres heretofore irrigated is 40 acres.
8. Number of acres proposed to be irrigated is 40 acres.
9. Description of land proposed to be irrigated is as follows: SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Sec. 34, T. 8 S., R. 67 E., M. D. B. & M..
10. Description of proposed works: Water will be diverted by means of a dam, and conveyed by means of a ditch to a reservoir located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Sec. 34, T. 7 S., R. 67 E., M. D. B. & M., from the reservoir the water will be conveyed by means of the natural channel of the stream to a point in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Sec. 22, T. 8 S., R. 67 E., M. D. B. & M., where it will be re-diverted into a ditch to the land proposed to be irrigated.
11. Estimated cost of proposed works is \$1000.00
12. Estimated time required to construct the works is Two (2) Years.
13. Irrigation will begin about February 1st of each year, and end about October 31st of each year.
14. Remarks:- The proof of application of water to a beneficial use as filed January 11, 1917 under permit No. 2306 by Joseph H. Foreman, describes the following legal subdivisions of land as having been irrigated: 10 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Sec. 34, T. 8 S., R. 67 E., and 30 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Sec. 2, T. 9 S., R. 67 E., M. D. B. & M.. whereas the application described the land proposed to be irrigated as follows: NW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Sec. 11, T. 8 S., R. 67 E., M. D. B. & M., It is the intention of this application for change in point of diversion, and place of use, to correct the errors made in the former application No. 2306, and retain the original date of priority as of January 6th, 1912.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit, to change the point of diversion and place of use of water allowed under Permit No. 2306, issued with the understanding that no new or additional rights are granted and with the further understanding that the changes proposed herein will not interfere with any prior rights on the source. A substantial headgate and weir must be installed at or near the new point of diversion in order to facilitate the measurement and control of water. The state reserves the right to regulate the use of the water under this proposed change at any and all times. It is distinctly understood that applicant agrees to the terms herein contained.

The amount of water to be changed shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 160 acre feet per annum.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before June 13, 1925.

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before July 13, 1925.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before June 13, 1926.

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before July 13, 1926.

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before June 13, 1927. Proof of the application of water to beneficial use must be filed with State Engineer on or before July 13, 1927.
