- (g) Remarks Applicant has been using Chin Creek for irrigation pur-
poses on the land described, having diverted it from its
channel at points described and wishes by this application to clear
his title for the use of this water on said land. Applicant is liv-
ing on the land and intends to homestead as soon as the land is sur-
veyed.

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED WORKS

By means of a small earth dam at the point of diversion, thence by State manner in which water is to be diverted, whether by dam or other works, whether through pipes, ditches, flumes, or other conduits. If water ditch onto a portion of the land irrigated from thence it is carried in the main channel, which is used as main ditch to a point, which bears from the SE. Cor. T. 26 N., R. 67 E., S. 4° 40' W., 17,400 ft., whence the water is carried in small ditches to portions of the land above described, thence carried in the main channel which is again used as a main ditch to a point, whence the SE. Cor. T. 26 N., R. 67 E., bears N. 1° 30' E., 16,000 ft. from whence it is carried in ditches.

- 5. Estimated cost of works \$1,000.00
6. Estimated time required to construct works one year.
7. Remarks/ersion from the main channel are necessary to most economically handle and conserve the water and the applicant requests one year in which to improve and complete the present irrigation system.


