permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as



DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED WORKS

Dam to be constructed of rocks, willows and earth at point of diversion, and water to be conveyed by means of open cuts, ditch, tunnel, and flumes to place of use. This ditch, about seven miles in length, was constructed many years ago at a cost of probably \$35,000.00. The cost of cleaning and repairing the ditch is estimated by the applicant herein at \$2,000.00

- 5. Estimated cost of works \$2,000.00
6. Estimated time required to construct works one year
7. Remarks Water will be used from about March 1 to about January first of the year following, weather conditions permitting.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 12.00 cubic feet per second.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before June 17, 1923.

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before July 17, 1923.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before June 17, 1924.

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before July 17, 1924.

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before November 17, 1925.

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use must be filed with State Engineer on or before December 17, 1925.

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This permit is issued subject to all prior rights on the stream system of which this source is tributary, and with the understanding that the water will be returned to the stream at the point designated in the application undiminished in quantity, except for the usual seepage and evaporation losses, and free from tailings or other deleterious matter. It is further understood that the amount of water herein set forth is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the amount of water actually diverted for beneficial purposes. Provision must be made for the installation of a measuring device and accurate measurements of the water placed to a beneficial use must be included in the proof of beneficial use when filed. The State reserves the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times. It is distinctly understood that applicant agrees to the terms herein contained.
