(g) Remarks Applicant will construct a concrete or rockfilled dam  
at the above described point of diversion. The normal flow of the  
river will at no time be interferred with. Application for permit  
to appropriate 180,000 second feet of water for power purposes is  
filed contemporaneously herewith

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED WORKS

A concrete or rockfilled dam will be constructed at the point of diversion above described, which will be 610 feet long at the bottom and 75 feet high from the low water level of the river.

More detailed descriptions will be filed as soon as surveys are completed. The reservoir will have a capacity of 395,325 acre-feet and the land in the Colorado River Basin above Bullhead Rock and below the 570 foot contour will be submerged.
