

TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS OF THE STATE OF NEVADA

The undersigned West End Chemical Company, a corporation,
of Las Vegas, County of Clark,
State of Nevada, hereby make application for
permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as
hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation, give date and place
of incorporation.) Incorporated, California Feby. 26, 1920.

- 1. The source of the proposed appropriation is the flood waters of Lovell Wash, a branch of Callville Wash in Clark County, Nevada.
2. The amount of water applied for is twenty (20) second-feet.
3. The water to be used for mining and domestic
4. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point: N.42°10' E., 3,068 feet from the Section corner common to Secs. 10-11-14 and 15 Tp. 20 S., R. 65 E., M.D.B. & M.

(g) Remarks It is proposed to store all of the flood waters of such wash as is possible at the time of rains, and to use the same for domestic purposes at the mining camp, employing at present 100 men, with possible extension to 500 men; also water for milling purposes, one unit of which is now in operation; water also for fire protection at mill and mining camp; also water for drilling machinery in mine; also water supply for operation of proposed railroad to the works, the survey of which has been made.

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED WORKS

The water is to be stored in a reservoir to be formed in the wash by State manner in which water is to be diverted, whether by dam or other works, whether through pipes, ditches, flumes, or other conduits. If water the construction of a dam 50 ft. in height, such dam to be located

is to be stored in reservoirs, it should be so stated and the location of the reservoir should be given with reference to the legal subdivisions.

at N.42°10' E., 3,068 ft. from the Sec. corner common to Secs. 10-11-14 & 15, Tp. 20 S., R. 65 E., M.D.B. & M., and water to be conducted from the point of dam to the mine, mill, camp and railroad at place above indicated, by means of 6 in. iron pipe. The exact description of the high water countour of the reservoir will be designated on and set forth in a map to be filed under this application.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: This permit is issued subject to all prior rights on the source. It is understood that the 2000 acre feet herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the amount of water actually stored for beneficial purposes each season. Data regarding the size and capacity of the reservoir, together with the number of times same is filled each season, will be required to be included in the proof of beneficial use when filed. The State reserves the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 2,000.00 acre season. cubic feet per second.

- Actual construction work shall begin on or before July 24, 1923.
Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before August 24, 1923.
Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before July 24, 1926.
Proof of completion of work shall be filed before August 24, 1926.
Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before July 24, 1928.
Proof of the application of water to beneficial use must be filed with State Engineer on or before August 24, 1928.
