

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: This permit is issued subject to all prior rights on the source. It is understood that the 1.0 cubic foot of water per second herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the amount of water actually placed to a beneficial use. A suitable measuring device must be installed and accurate measurements of the water placed to a beneficial use must be included in the proof of beneficial use when filed. The State reserves the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times. It is distinctly understood that applicant agrees to the terms herein contained. The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 1.0 cubic foot per second.

- Actual construction work shall begin on or before June 17, 1924
- Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before July 17, 1924
- Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before June 17, 1928
- Proof of completion of work shall be filed before July 17, 1928
- Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before June 17, 1929
- Proof of the application of water to beneficial use must be filed with State Engineer on or before July 17, 1929
