OF THE WATERS OF THE STATE OF NEVADA.

The undersigned, P. Y. GILLSON of Reno, County of Washoe,  
State of Nevada, hereby makes application to change the point of  
diversion of waters heretofore applied for under application  
No. 5507.

- The source of the water proposed to be changed is flood waters  
of Steamboat Creek.  
The quantity of water desired to be changed is four (4)  
second feet.
3. The water is to be used for irrigation and domestic use.
  4. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following  
point: The NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 27, T. 19 N., R. 20 E.,
  5. The point of diversion under the former application is as  
follows: The NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 27, T. 19 N., R. 20 E.
  6. The water herewith desired to be changed was originally  
applied for under application No. 5507 for the following  
described lands: E $\frac{1}{2}$ ; SW $\frac{1}{4}$ ; and S $\frac{1}{2}$  of NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 27,  
T. 19 N., R. 20 E.
  7. The number of acres heretofore proposed to be irrigated under  
application No. 5507 is 500 acres.
  8. The number of acres now proposed to be irrigated is 500 acres.
  9. Description of land proposed to be irrigated is the same as  
that heretofore described in former application No. 5507 which  
is identical with that enumerated under (6) above.
  10. Description of proposed works is: Short ditch line from point  
of diversion to pump and thence by pipe line and small ditches  
to land to be irrigated.
  11. Estimated cost of proposed works is: about Five Thousand  
(\$5,000.) dollars.
  12. Estimated time required to construct the works is: Three years.
  13. Irrigation will begin about March 1st of each year and end  
about October 1st of each year.
  14. Remarks:

The reason for making this application to change point  
of diversion is to avoid pumping water over a hill. There are  
no other diversions between the point proposed under application  
No. 5507 and the point described herein.
