The undersigned George Itzania, (A citizen of the United States)
of Gerlach, County of Washoe, State of Nevada, hereby makes application for
permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as
hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation, give date and place
of incorporation.)

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Spring, no name.

2. The amount of water applied for is one-tenth second-feet.
One-second-foot equals 40 miners' inches

3. The water to be used for Stockwatering and domestic purposes



This permit is issued subject to all prior rights on the source. The State reserves the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times. It is distinctly understood that applicant agrees to the terms herein contained.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.0125 cubic foot per second.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before July 6, 1925

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before August 6, 1925

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before July 6, 1926

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before August 6, 1926

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before July 6, 1927

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use must be filed with State Engineer on or before August 6, 1927
