This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: This permit is issued subject to all prior rights on the source, and with the understanding that the water herein granted will be returned to the stream at the point designated in the application free from deleterious matter, and with the further understanding that the proof of beneficial use, when filed, will show the power generated and the amount of water required and used therefor. The state reserves the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times. It is understood that the right herein granted will not infringe upon or affect any rights set forth in the decree in the matter of the White River Adjudication. The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 4 cubic feet per second.
