This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: This permit is issued subject to all prior rights on the source. A substantial headgate and weir must be installed and maintained at or near the point of diversion to facilitate the measurement and control of water. The State reserves the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times. It is distinctly understood that applicant agrees to the terms herein contained.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 1.5 cubic feet per second.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before May 14, 1926

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before June 14, 1926

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before November 14, 1926

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before December 14, 1926

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before

November 14, 1930. Proof of the application of water to beneficial

use must be filed with State Engineer on or before December 14, 1930.
