The undersigned L.L. Gilcrease and Elda A. Gilcrease, of Las Vegas, County of Clark, State of Nevada, hereby makes application to change the use and manner of use, of waters heretofore appropriated and beneficially used as hereinafter shown.

1. The source of water supply is the same as that described in Application Serial Numbered 5070 of the records and files in the office of the State Engineer of Nevada, to-wit: Spring known as Tule Spring, located in the Northeast (NE) corner of the South-East Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of the Southwest Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section Nine (9), Township Nineteen (19) South, Range Sixty (60) East, Mount Diablo Base and Meridian, Clark County, Nevada.
2. The quantity of water desired to be changed is 1.6 c.f.s.
3. The water is to be used for irrigation and domestic purposes.
4. The water is to be diverted from its source as hereinabove described and is more particularly described in said Application Serial Numbered 5070.
5. The manner of use under said Application Serial Numbered 5070 and the Permit thereupon granted, was for cattle, domestic and the irrigation of the following described land, situated in said County of Clark, State of Nevada, to-wit: The South Half (S $\frac{1}{2}$ ) of the Southeast Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{2}$ ) of Section Nine (9), and the South Half (S $\frac{1}{2}$ ) of the Southwest Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{2}$ ) of Section Ten (10) Township Nineteen (19) South, Range Sixty (60) East, Mount Diablo Base and Meridian.
6. The water, herewith desired to be changed, has been beneficially and continuously used upon the following described lands: Eighteen and Five Tenths (18.5) acres in vineyard, located in the East Half (E $\frac{1}{2}$ ) of the Northeast Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section Twenty-two (22), said Township; Twenty-two (22) acres in alfalfa in North-West Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section Twenty-three (23), said Township; and Seventeen (17) acres in orchard, garden, nursery and vineyard located in the Northwest Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section Twenty-three (23) said Township.
7. Number of acres heretofore irrigated is Fifty-seven and Five Tenths (57.5) as above stated.
8. Number of acres proposed to be irrigated is 160.
9. Description of the land proposed to be irrigated is as follows:  
(a) The land described above, Fifty-seven and Five Tenths (57.5) acres. (b) Thirty-four (34) acres in the South (S) portions of the East Half (E $\frac{1}{2}$ ) of the Northeast Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of said Section Twenty-two (22). (c) Southwest Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Northwest Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of said Section Twenty-three (23), containing Forty (40) acres. (d) Twenty acres (20) in Southeast Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of the Northwest Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of said Section Twenty-three (23). (e) Eight and Five-tenths (8.5) acres in the Northeast Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of the Northeast Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of said Section Twenty-two (22).
10. Description of proposed works: An extension of the irrigation system by the construction of necessary additional ditches and laterals so as to irrigate said land according to the Map accompanying this Application.
11. Estimated cost of proposed works is Two Hundred (\$200) Dollars.
12. Estimated time to construct the works is Six (6) months.
13. Irrigation will begin about January 1st of each year and end about December 31st of each year.
14. The water has been used, heretofore, during the entire year.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit, to change the place of use of water heretofore granted under permit No. 5070, is issued with the understanding that no valid rights will be affected by the change proposed herein. A substantial headgate and weir must be installed at or near the point of diversion to facilitate the measurement and control of water. The State reserves the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The amount of water to be changed shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 1.6 cubic feet per second.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before October 11, 1927.

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before November 11, 1927.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before April 11, 1928.

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before May 11, 1928.

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before October 11, 1931. Proof of the application of water to beneficial use must be filed with State Engineer on or before November 11, 1931.
