- 1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Tony Creek and
Tributaries (Chimney Creek and others)
2. The amount of water applied for is 3.20 second-feet.
3. The water to be used for Irrigation stock and domestic purposes

(c) Irrigation will begin about March 1st and end about
September 30th, of each year.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to all prior rights on the source. A substantial headgate and weir must be installed and maintained at or near the point of diversion and facilitate the measurement and control of water. The State reserves the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times. It is distinctly understood that applicant agrees to the terms herein contained.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 3.2 cubic feet per second.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before July 26, 1926

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before August 26, 1926

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before July 26, 1928

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before August 26, 1928

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before July 26, 1932

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use must be filed with State Engineer on or before August 26, 1932
