- 1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Rabbit Hole Canyon
2. The amount of water applied for is two second-feet.
3. The water to be used for Mining and domestic purposes
4. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point: N. 53°54' W. 6080 feet from N 1/4 Cor. Sec. 2, T. 32 N., R. 29 E., of Mt. Diablo B. & M. (The point of diversion is on unsurveyed land)

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to all prior rights on the source. It is understood that the 2 cubic feet of water per second herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the amount of water actually placed to a beneficial use. A suitable measuring device must be installed and accurate measurements of the water placed to a beneficial use must be included in the proof of such use when filed. The State reserves the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 2 cubic feet per second.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before October 12, 1926

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before November 12, 1926

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 12, 1929

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before November 12, 1929

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before October 12, 1930

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use must be filed with State Engineer on or before November 12, 1930
