of Hawthorne, County of Mineral, State of Nevada, hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation.)

- 1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Powell Creek, on west side of Whiskey Flat, Mineral County, Nevada.
2. The amount of water applied for is two (2) second-feet.
3. The water to be used for Stockwatering purposes.
4. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point: About the center of SE 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 2, T. 5 N., R. 30 E., MDB&M.

IF THE WATER IS TO BE USED FOR IRRIGATION, SUPPLY THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- (c) Use of water Irrigation will begin about January 1st and end about December 31st, of each year.

(g) Remarks As there is only water in this stream during the early part of the year, and not later than July, in average years, the water can only be used during such season. 100 head of cattle will be watered.

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED WORKS

Water to be diverted from stream by small dam, thence thru pipes to watering troughs for stock.

State manner in which water is to be diverted, whether by dam or other works, whether through pipes, ditches, flumes, or other conduits. If water is to be stored in reservoirs, it should be so stated and the location of the reservoir should be given with reference to the legal subdivisions.

5. Estimated cost of works One Hundred and Fifty (\$150.00) Dollars.

6. Estimated time required to construct works One Month.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.003 cubic feet per second.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before September 12, 1926

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before October 12, 1926

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 12, 1926.

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before November 12, 1926

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before October 12, 1927. Proof of the application of water to beneficial

use must be filed with State Engineer on or before November 12, 1927
