hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation.)

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is underground water in flat south of Chalk Mountain

2. The amount of water applied for is two second-feet.

3. The water to be used for mining and domestic

4. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point: Commencing at N.W. corner of section 30 T 17 N. R. 35 E. M. D. B. M. running thence S. 66° 24' W 8520 feet to the N.E. corner of Amo No 2 Lode mining claim thence S. 66° -27' W 1000 feet to mine shaft point of development on unsurveyed ground, or S. 66° 24' 18.5" W. 9519.96 feet or approximately in the NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 26, T. 17 N. R. 34 E.

We are still sinking and cannot tell how much water can be developed or the cost. We wish to appropriate all water developed for mining and domestic purposes at Chalk Mountain. We are unable to tell at this time how large a mill will be required.

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED WORKS

We will use pumps and pipelines.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

~~This permit is issued subject to all prior rights. It is understood that the 2.0 Cubic feet of water per second herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the amount of water actually placed to a beneficial use. A suitable measuring device must be installed and accurate measurements of the water placed to a beneficial use must be included in the proof of such use when filed. The State reserves the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.~~

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 2.0 cubic feet per second.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before September 15, 1926

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before October 15, 1926

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before September 15, 1928

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before October 15, 1928

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before _____

September 15, 1929 Proof of the application of water to beneficial

use must be filed with State Engineer on or before October 15, 1929
