permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as
hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation, give date and place
of incorporation.)

- 1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Cat Creek
Name of stream, lake, or other source
2. The amount of water applied for is 2 second-feet.
One-second-foot equals 40 miners' inches
3. The water to be used for Irrigation and domestic
Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic, or other use
4. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point:
From the 1/4 corner between Sections 13 and 24 Twp. 8 North Range 29 E
Describe as being within a 40-acre subdivision of public survey, or by course and distance to a section-corner. If on unsurveyed land, it should be so stated.
The headgate bears N. 84°35' W. 1552 ft.

and certificate No. 464 has been issued thereunder for water for
38.39 acres. Application is made to acquire a water right for
the balance of the land in the 160 acre tract above described by
the means explained hereafter.

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED WORKS :

A concrete dam will be constructed at the mouth of the canyon at Cat State manner in which water is to be diverted, whether by dam or other works, whether through pipes, ditches, flumes, or other conduits. If water is to be stored in reservoirs, it should be so stated and the location of the reservoir should be given with reference to the legal subdivisions. Creek to bring to the surface the water which now sinks below this point. Water which is thus developed will be used to irrigate additional lands within the tract hereafter described by means of a ditch.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: This permit is issued subject to all prior rights on the source. A substantial headgate and weir must be installed and maintained at or near the point of diversion to facilitate the measurement and control of water. The State reserves the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times. The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 1.2 cubic feet per second.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before May 16, 1927

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before June 16, 1927

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before August 16, 1927

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before September 16, 1927

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before

August 16, 1930. Proof of the application of water to beneficial

use must be filed with State Engineer on or before September 16, 1930
