permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as

Actual construction work shall begin on or before August 25, 1926

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before September 25, 1926

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before August 25, 1927

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before September 25, 1927

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before August 25, 1928

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use must be filed with State Engineer on or before September 25, 1928
