This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.5 cubic feet per second.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before April 12, 1927

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before May 12, 1927

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 12, 1927

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before November 12, 1927

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before October 12, 1928. Proof of the application of water to beneficial

use must be filed with State Engineer on or before November 12, 1928

Proof of labor filed Mar. 6, 1927

This permit is issued subject to all prior rights and with the understanding that the applicant company will install and maintain during the grazing season from May 1st to October 31st of each year, so long as they shall continue milling operations necessitating their use of the waters of the springs, four watering troughs to be located at the following points:

1. NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 8; Township 16 N., Range 58 E.
2. NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 6; " " " " "
3. SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 2; " " " " 57 "; and
4. To be located approximately in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 1, Township 16 N., Range 57 E., about midway between the main California Mill Spring on the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 6, Township 16 N., Range 58 E., and their milling plant.

Each of the watering troughs so to be installed by them to be equipped with a floating valve, so as to insure an adequate supply of water at all times without waste.

It will, of course, be understood that such user on the part of the livestock men shall not endow them with any right or interest in the pipeline or water works installed by the mining company for milling purposes, and that there will be no interference by the livestock men with any of the mining company's equipment, their rights in the premises to be confined to the use of the water without claim of ownership as to any of the property installed by the mining company for its transportation and use.

It is further understood that the 0.5 cubic foot of water per second herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the amount of water actually placed to a beneficial use. A suitable measuring device must be installed and accurate measurements of the water placed to a beneficial use must be included in the proof of such use when filed. The State reserves the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.
