

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED WORKS

The water will be diverted from its source by means of an open cut State manner in which water is to be diverted, whether by dam or other works, whether through pipes, ditches, flumes, or other conduits. If water and a ditch line leading from said spring to and over the lands to be irrigated. is to be stored in reservoirs, it should be so stated and the location of the reservoir should be given, with reference to the legal subdivisions.

The stock will be watered by small reservoir at the point of diversion.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to all prior rights on the source. A substantial weir must be installed to facilitate the measurement of water. The State reserves the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.40 cubic feet per second.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before August 1, 1936

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before September 1, 1936

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before August 1, 1938

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before September 1, 1938

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before August 1, 1939

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use must be filed with State Engineer on or before September 1, 1939
