The undersigned UNITED CATTLE & PACKING COMPANY, a corporation
of Reno, County of Washoe, State of Nevada, hereby make application for
permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as
hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation, give date and place
of incorporation.) Incorporated under laws of Nevada-1916

- 1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Rye Patch Channel
2. The amount of water applied for is one second-foot.
3. The water to be used for stockwatering, irrigation and domestic
4. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point:

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: This permit is issued subject to all existing rights on the source. It is understood that the amount of water herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the period of use and the average number of cattle served from the water of this source. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times but does not take responsibility for the use of the Federal range.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.0625

cubic feet per second., or sufficient water to water 2,000 cattle from November 1st to July 1st of the following year.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 26, 1970

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before April 26, 1970

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before March 26, 1971

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before April 26, 1971

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before

March 26, 1973

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use must be filed with State Engineer on or before April 26, 1973
