## APPLICATION FOR PERMISSION TO CHANGE POINT OF DIVERSION

OF THE WATERS OF THE STATE OF NEVADA

The undersigned Licking Land and Livestock Company, formerly known as the McIntyre Starrett Company, a corporation organized under the laws of the State of Nevada, principal place of business Battle Mountain, Nevada, hereby makes application to change the point of diversion of waters heretofore appropriated and beneficially used as hereinafter shown.

1. The source of the water supply proposed to be changed is the Humboldt River.
2. The quantity of water desired to be changed is the amount heretofore appropriated and beneficially used; set forth in the Order of Determination of the State Engineer at page 103 thereof under proof #00164 as a continuous flow of 5.505 cubic feet per second during the irrigation season; subject to change as provided by section 36a, chapter 106, Nevada Statutes of 1921.
3. The water is to be used for irrigation and stock watering purposes.
4. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following points: a point in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Sec. 16, T. 32 N. R. 45 E, whence to the SW corner of section 16 above described bears S 17 degrees and 55 minutes W, 2725 feet; a point in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Sec. 16 above described, whence to the SW corner of the same section bears S 31 degrees W 3760 feet. Water to be diverted thru headgates at the above described points by means of a diversion dam located at a point in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Sec. 16 above described, whence to the SW corner of the same section bears S 27 degrees W. 3525 feet.
5. The existing points of diversion under the present appropriation are as follows: A point in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Sec. 16 above described whence to the SW corner of the same bears S 2 degrees and 05 minutes E 3785 feet; a point in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Sec. 16 above whence to the SW corner of the same bears S 13 degrees and 15 minutes W 4385 feet. Water heretofore diverted at the above mentioned points thru headgates by means of a dam located at a point in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Sec. 8, T. 32 N. R. 45 E, whence to the SW corner of Sec. 16 same bears S 1 degree and 50 minutes E 5400 feet.
6. The water herewith desired to be changed has been continuously and beneficially used on the following described lands: The irrigated portions of, the W $\frac{1}{2}$  of Sec. 9; the east  $\frac{1}{2}$  of Sec. 8; the N $\frac{1}{2}$  of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Sec 17; and those portions of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Sec. 16, and of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of section 17 lying to the N and W of the County road; all in T. 32 N. R. 45 E. More particularly described in the records of the State Engineers office under proof #00164, claimant Wm. Licking.
7. The number of acres heretofore irrigated is 677.11.
8. The number of acres proposed to be irrigated is the same.
9. The description of the land proposed to be irrigated is the same as that of the land which has heretofore been irrigated.
10. The proposed works consist of concrete headgates 16 by 5 feet at each of the proposed points of diversion; ditches connecting these points with those formerly used; and of a concrete diversion dam allowing a clear space of 60 by 8 feet for the river flow.
11. The estimated cost of the proposed works is \$2500.00.
12. The estimated time necessary to complete the works is two months.
13. Irrigation will begin about Mar, 15th, and end about Sept. 15th, of each year.
14. The water has been heretofore used during the same period.
15. The proposed change is rendered necessary by the decision of this Company to abandon its present system of flood irrigation. The present dam, a

willow and rock structure, cannot be remade to suit this type of irrigation. Owing to sandy banks and the proximity of old channels any dam located at or near the present location would be un safe.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion of the waters of the Humboldt River heretofore appropriated as defined by the Decree of the Court in the Humboldt River Adjudication is issued with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. A substantial headgate or headgates must be installed to facilitate the measurement and control of water. The State reserves the right to regulate the use of water under this proposed change at any and all times.

The amount of water to be changed shall be limited to 5.517 c.f.s. in continuous flow or a total of 1751.56 acre feet for the irrigation season as fixed by the Court Decree, or that amount of water which may hereafter be allowed by any modification of the Court Decree in the duty of water for the lands irrigated.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before June 1, 1939.

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed on or before July 1, 1939.


Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before June 1, 1941.

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before July 1, 1941.

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before June 1, 1942. Proof of the application of water to beneficial use must be filed with the State Engineer on or before July 1, 1942.
