The undersigned, ARGENTA LAND & CATTLE COMPANY, a corporation of Battle Mountain, Lander County, Nevada, organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Utah, incorporated in the year 1922, hereby makes application for permission to change the point of diversion of waters heretofore appropriated and beneficially used, as hereinafter shown.

1. The source of the water supply of the proposed change is Humboldt River.

2. The amount of water applied for to be changed is 44.30 cubic feet per second.

3. The water is to be used for irrigation, stockwatering and domestic purposes.

4. The water is to be diverted under the new point of diversion from its source at the following point:

NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 16, T. 32 N., R. 45 E., M. D. B. & M. whence to SW corner of Section 16 bears S. 17°55' W. 2725 ft.; SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 16 whence to SW corner of Section 16 bears S. 31° W. 3760 ft. The dam carrying water through said points is to be constructed at a point in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 16, T. 32 N., R. 45 E. whence to the SW corner of said section 16 bears S. 27° W. 3525 ft.

5. The water has been diverted heretofore from the Humboldt River at the following points:

SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 16, whence to SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Section 16 bears S. 2° 5' E. 3785 ft; NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Section 16, whence to SW corner of said Section 16 bears S. 13° 15' E. 4385 ft. The dam diverting water through said points is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 8, T. 32 N., R. 45 E. whence to SW corner said Section 16 bears S. 1° 50' E. 5400 ft.

10. The works will consist of a diversion dam of concrete or lumber or both, with stone riprap into a proposed ditch which extends from the head of the former ditches to the new points of diversion through which the water will be conducted to the former existing ditches, and will be distributed for beneficial purposes as heretofore stated.

11. The estimated cost of the proposed works is \$1,000.00

12. The estimated time required to construct the works is one year.

13. Irrigation will begin about March 1st of each year and end about November 1st of each year; but without specifically limiting the season the water will be used as heretofore, whenever conditions permit the beneficial use thereof at anytime of the year.

14. The water has been used heretofore at all times of the year when the same could be beneficially used and particularly from March 1st to November 1st inclusive.

15. The priority of the right, as well as the extent thereof, is shown by the proof of appropriation of Land Development Company, predecessor of Argenta Land & Cattle Company, on file in the office of the State Engineer and referred to as proof No. C0163 to which reference is hereby made and made a part hereof. The said priority being claims as of the year 1869.

REMARKS: The acreage referred to hereinabove has been in part at times in the past partially irrigated by means of water diverted from another ditch of Argenta Land & Cattle Company from the same source. That is to say, that a portion of the acreage may be irrigated from another ditch or ditches at times, namely: The Rocky Point Canal, feeding the sloughs and irrigation system of the company but it is intended by this application to irrigate from the new point of diversion all land that has ever been irrigated from the old points of diversion a short distance lower on the stream
