permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as
hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation, give date and place

- 1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Unnamed spring

2. The amount of water applied for is 2500 sheep second-feet.
One-second-foot equals 40 miners' inches
3. The water to be used for Stockwatering
Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic, or other use
4. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point:
SW 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 36, T. 31 N; R. 52 E., M.D.B.&M., or N. 55 00' E.
Describe as being within a 40-acre subdivision of public survey, or by course and distance to a section-corner. If on unsurveyed land, it should be so stated.
1200 feet distant from the S.W. Cor. Sec. 36, T. 31 N; R. 52 E.

(g) Remarks This spring has never been used by anyone unless by
Wood Choppers some thirty years ago and would not water over
fifty sheep without development work. It is doubtful, even
then, if sufficient flow can be obtained for the required use
as the spring comes out of solid rock and goes dry usually in
June.

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED WORKS

State manner in which water is to be diverted, whether by dam or other works, whether through pipes, ditches, flumes, or other conduits. If water

is to be stored in reservoirs, it should be so stated and the location of the reservoir should be given with reference to the legal subdivisions.

- 6. Estimated time required to construct works One month.
- 7. Remarks Later we intend to pipe the water farther out into the flat where stock will have easier access to troughs, but the cost is prohibitive at this time.

This Permit is issued subject to all prior rights on the source. The State reserves the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed .016 or sufficient to water 2500 head of sheep. cubic feet per second.


Actual construction work shall begin on or before June 1, 1930
Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before July 1, 1930
Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before June 1, 1931.

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before July 1, 1931
Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before June 1, 1933. Proof of the application of water to beneficial use must be filed with State Engineer on or before July 1, 1933
