This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to all prior rights on the Source. The State reserves the right to regulate the use of the waters herein granted at any and all times.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed .0625

cubic feet per second., or sufficient to water 10,000 head of sheep.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before August 1, 1928.

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before September 1, 1928

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before August 1, 1929.

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before September 1, 1929

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before August 1, 1931

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use must be filed with State Engineer on or before September 1, 1931

Proof of labor filed - 4-4-31. Map filed Sept 9, 1927. Proof of completion of work filed - 4-4-31. Proof of beneficial use filed - 5-12-33.
