of Preston, County of White Pine, State of Nevada, hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation.) March 24, 1911, Prin. Office. Preston, Nevada Nev. Corp.

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Jake's Wash Reservoir
Name of stream, lake, or other source

2. The amount of water applied for is 1500 acre second-feet.
One-second-foot equals 40 miners' inches

3. The water to be used for Stock watering purposes.
Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic, or other use

4. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point:

At a point from which the S.E. corner of Sec. 35, T. 14 N; R. 61 E.,
Describe as being within a 40-acre subdivision of public survey, or by course and distance to a section-corner. If on unsurveyed land, it should be so stated.

(The exterior boundaries of which are surveyed. The sections is not subdivided.) bears N. 33 degrees 45 minutes E. a distance of 3,594 feet and in the NW 1/4 SE 1/4 S2, T. 13 N; R. 61 E.

(i) Remarks The applicat now has a permit for this water for irrigation purposes, and this application is made for the purpose of also securing a permit for stock watering purposes.

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED WORKS

Water which goes to waste in what is locally known as Jakes Wash will be stored in a dirt dam reservoir approximately 1,200 feet in length, 130 feet in width at base and 30 feet high equipped with an iron pipe and concrete abutment. The pipe to be equipped with valve gate to regulate flow of water and spillway in case of cloudbursts.

- 5. Estimated cost of works \$3,000
6. Estimated time required to construct works Three years.
7. Remarks A dam approximately 400 feet in length has already been

constructed. The water is waste water from the Jakes Wash drainage being impounded in Jakes Wash reservoir for irrigation purposes. Live stock water at the reservoir which is the place of use.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: This Permit is issued subject to all prior rights on the source. The State reserves the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.011

cubic feet per second, or 8 acre feet storage per annum exclusive of evaporation and seepage losses or sufficient to water 250 cattle, 500 sheep. Actual construction work shall begin on or before September 1, 1932

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before October 1, 1932

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before September 1, 1933

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before October 1, 1933

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before September 1, 1935.

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use must be filed with State Engineer on or before October 1, 1935.
