The undersigned Carson and Tahoe Lumber and Fluming Company
of Carson City, Nevada, County of Ormsby, State of Nevada, hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation.) November 26, 1873 (Nevada.)

- 1. The source of the proposed appropriation is High Meadow Springs
2. The amount of water applied for is 1.5 second-feet.
3. The water to be used for domestic, irrigation and stock watering
4. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point:
A point that bears South 16°20' E., 206.4 ft. from the 1/4 Corner common to Sections 26 and 35, T. 14 N; R. 18 E., Being in the NW 1/4 of NE 1/4 of Sec. 35, Tp. 14 N; R. 18 E.

IF THE WATER IS TO BE USED FOR IRRIGATION, SUPPLY THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- (a) Number of acres to be irrigated is Approximately 200 acres.
(b) Description of land to be irrigated Lots 2, 3, and 4, SE 1/4 of NE 1/4, E 1/2 of SE 1/4, Sec. 22; Lot 1, 2 and 3, E 1/2 and SW 1/4 of NE 1/4, Sec. 27, Tp. 14 N; R. 18 E.
(c) Irrigation will begin about April 1st and end about December 1, of each year.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: This permit is issued subject to all existing rights on the source. A substantial headgate and measuring device must be installed and maintained to facilitate the measurement and control of water. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times. This permit is issued subject to the final allocation of the State of Nevada under The California-Nevada Interstate Compact Commission.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 1.5

cubic feet per second, but not to exceed a seasonal duty of 4.0 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated from any and/or all sources.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before July 20, 1967.

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before August 20, 1967.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before July 20, 1968.

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before August 20, 1968.

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before July 20, 1970. Proof of the application of water to beneficial

use must be filed with State Engineer on or before August 20, 1970.
