The undersigned Mrs. Lena Harkey Scott
of Eagleville, County of Modoc, State of California, hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated.

- 1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Upper Grassy Spring
2. The amount of water applied for is 0.10 second-feet.
3. The water to be used for Stockwatering
4. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point: S. 2°00' W. 4560 ft. from the northeast corner of section 4



(e) Works to be located probably the SE 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 4, T. 41 N; R. 21 E., M.D.M.

(g) State number and kinds of animals to be watered 2000 head of sheep, 200 head of cattle and horses.
(h) Use will begin about March and end about December, of each year.
(i) Remarks three springs to be connected by means of small ditches and water to conveyed to small pool 20 ft. diam. and 2 ft. deep about twenty feet below springs

If water conveyed to pool: 20 ft. diameter 2 ft. deep at point about twenty ft. westerly of springs.

7. Remarks This water has been used by me or my predecessors for the last forty years, using the springs (which are natural water holes) and am only making this application to correct any errors there may be in regard to description and etc.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to all prior rights on the source. The State reserves the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.03125 cubic feet per second.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before July 1, 1939

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before August 1, 1939

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before July 1, 1941.

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before August 1, 1941

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before July 1, 1942.

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use must be filed with State Engineer on or before August 1, 1942
