(i) Remarks The land to be irrigated is practically all under cultivation. Said land has a water right from the Carson River during times of the year, and the purpose of this application is to augment the Carson River water supply which is insufficient, and to use water from the well on all of the land at such times of the year when there is no supply whatever available from the Carson River.

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED WORKS

A well has been drilled to a depth of 300 feet and a Western deep State manner in which water is to be diverted, whether by dam or other works, whether through pipes, ditches, flumes, or other conduits. If water well turbine pump and a 40 h.p. motor have been installed. is to be stored in reservoirs, it should be so stated and the location of the reservoir should be given with reference to the legal subdivisions. Water is pumped into and distributed to land through ditches already built and in use.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This Permit is issued subject to all prior rights. A substantial weir must be installed and maintained to facilitate the measurement of water. The State reserves the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 1.6 cubic feet per second.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before Nov. 1, 1929

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before Dec. 1, 1929

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before Nov. 1, 1930

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before Dec. 1, 1930

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before Nov. 1, 1933

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use must be filed with State Engineer on or before Dec. 1, 1933
