The undersigned Alex Dufferrena of Denio, County of Humboldt, State of Nevada, hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation.)

3. The water to be used for Stock Watering
4. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point: SE 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 12, T. 47 N., R. 31 E., or N. 76 degrees 00' E., 1800 ft. distant from the 1/4 Cor. common to Secs. 12 and 13.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to all prior rights on the source. The state reserves the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed .03 or sufficient to water 5000 head of sheep. cubic feet per second.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before April 1, 1930

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before May 1, 1930

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before April 1, 1931

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before May 1, 1931

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before April 1, 1932. Proof of the application of water to beneficial use must be filed with State Engineer on or before May 1, 1932
