

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: This permit is issued subject to all prior rights on the source and with the understanding that no valid vested stockwatering rights will be impaired by the granting of the application. It is understood that the one cubic foot of water per second herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the amount of water actually placed to a beneficial use. A suitable measuring device must be installed and accurate measurements of the water placed to a beneficial use must be included in the proof of such use when filed. The State reserves the right to regulate the use of water herein granted at any and all times. The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed one cubic foot per second.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before Dec. 1, 1929

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before Jan. 1, 1930

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before Dec. 1, 1932.

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before Jan. 1, 1933

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before Dec. 1, 1933.

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use must be filed with State Engineer on or before Jan. 1, 1934
