AMENDED APPLICATION FOR PERMIT

TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS OF THE STATE OF NEVADA

The undersigned C. W. Godecke
of Minden, County of Douglas, State of Nevada, hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated.

- 1. The source of the proposed appropriation is an Artesian Well
2. The amount of water applied for is 0.25 second-feet.
3. The water to be used for Domestic and Irrigation purposes
4. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point: NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 8, T. 13 N; R. 20 E.

IF THE WATER IS TO BE USED FOR IRRIGATION, SUPPLY THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- (a) Number of acres to be irrigated is 20 acres
(b) Description of land to be irrigated S 1/2 NW 1/4 and N 1/2 SW 1/4 Sec. 8, T. 13 N; R. 20 E.

- (c) Use will begin about March 1 and end about Nov. 1, of each year.

IF WATER IS TO BE USED FOR POWER, MINING, STOCK WATERING, OR OTHER USE, SUPPLY THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- (d) Power to be developed is horsepower.
(e) Works to be located
(f) Point of return of water to stream
(g) State number and kinds of animals to be watered
(h) Use will begin about and end about, of each year.

(i) Remarks Water from this well is piped to buildings and the surplus is used for irrigation of garden and other land within the tract named above. The principal use of the water is for general domestic purposes and the watering of stock on the ranch and the irrigation of garden.

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED WORKS

Water is piped to dwelling, chicken houses, separator house and State manner in which water is to be diverted, whether by dam or other works, whether through pipes, ditches, flumes, or other conduits. If water troughs in the yard and corral for the watering of stock and is to be stored in reservoirs, it should be so stated and the location of the reservoir should be given with reference to the legal subdivisions.

general domestic purposes. A ditch conveys the water to the garden and the surplus is comingled with other water and used on grain and alfalfa land within the tract named under subdivision (b).

7. Remarks This well was drilled fifteen or more years ago and the water therefrom has been used in the manner above described for a number of years.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This Permit is issued subject to all prior rights. A substantial weir must be installed and maintained to facilitate the measurement of water. The State reserves the right to regulate use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed .25 cubic feet per second.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before Nov. 1, 1929

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before Dec. 1, 1929

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before Nov. 1, 1930

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before Dec. 1, 1930

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before Nov. 1, 1932

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use must be filed with State Engineer on or before Dec. 1, 1932
