The undersigned Marion Yelland Name of applicant
of Aurum, County of White Pine, State of Nevada, hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation.)

- 1. The source of the proposed appropriation is South Millick Spring Name of stream, lake, or other source
2. The amount of water applied for is one second-feet. One-second-foot equals 40 miners' inches
3. The water to be used for the watering of range livestock. Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic, or other use
4. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point: In the SE 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 25, T. 17 N; R. 67 E., or at a point N. 74 degrees Describe as being within a 40-acre subdivision of public survey, or by course and distance to a section-corner. If on unsurveyed land, it should be so stated. 41 minutes E. - 1,732 feet from the S. W. corner of Sec. 25, T. 17 N; R. 67 E.


IF THE WATER IS TO BE USED FOR IRRIGATION, SUPPLY THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- (a) Number of acres to be irrigated is

(e) Works to be located in the SE 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 25, T. 17 N; R. 67 E. Give 40-acre subdivision on which works will be located, or locate by course and distance to a section-corner.
(f) Point of return of water to stream Describe in same manner as point of diversion.
(g) State number and kinds of animals to be watered approximately 3000 head of sheep and 50 head of cattle will be watered at this source.
(h) Use will begin about Jan 1st and end about Dec. 31st, of each year. Month Month
(i) Remarks The waters of South Millick Spring has been used by the Yelland family for the watering of range livestock prior to 1890.



DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED WORKS

A dam will be constructed across the channel of the stream for the State manner in which water is to be diverted, whether by dam or other works, whether through pipes, ditches, flumes, or other conduits. If water storing of a sufficient amount of water for the amount of stock is to be stored in reservoirs, it should be so stated and the location of the reservoir should be given with reference to the legal subdivisions applied for.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to all prior rights on the source. The State reserves the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.03 cubic feet per second.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before October 1, 1939

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before November 1, 1939

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1941

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before November 1, 1941

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before

October 1, 1942. Proof of the application of water to beneficial use must be filed with State Engineer on or before November 1, 1942


