APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This Permit is issued subject to all prior rights. It is understood that the 0.50 of a cubic foot per second herein granted is only a temporary allowance and the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the amount of water actually placed to a beneficial use. It is further understood that accurate measurements of the water placed to beneficial use will be included in the proof of such use when filed. The State reserves the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.50 cubic feet per second.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before May 1, 1931

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before June 1, 1931

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before May 1, 1932

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before June 1, 1932

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before May 1, 1936

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use must be filed with State Engineer on or before June 1, 1936.
