The undersigned California Mother Lode Mining Company
of Reno, County of Washoe, State of Nevada, hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation.) Reno, Nevada, July 24, 1928.

- 1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Tiger Creek (Springs) in Tiger Canyon North of Olinghouse, Nevada., in Section 21, Township 21 North, Range 23 East, M.D.B.&M. Washoe County, Nevada, from said springs
2. The amount of water applied for is All water available second-feet. and also from flow from a mine prospect tunnel upstream above said springs.
3. The water to be used for Mining and Domestic use in connection with mining operations in Section 21, Twp. 21 N.R. 23 E. for domestic, or other use
4. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point: At main spring or series of springs in Tiger Canyon, the exact location to be determined by actual survey.

Describe as being within a 40-acre subdivision of public survey, or by course and distance to a section corner. If on unsurveyed land, it should be so stated. These springs are supposedly located in the S.E. 1/4 of N.E. 1/4 of Sec. 20, or, may be in the N.W. 1/4 of Sec- 21, Twp. 21 N.R. 23 E. They are close to dividing line between said sections. Must be surveyed for

(f) Point of return of water to stream Will be turned into Frank Free Canyon in the S.E. 1/4 of Sec. 21, and the N.E. 1/4 of Sec. 21 N. Range 23 East. Water to be carried by pipe line from point of diversion to points of use at mine camp and mill. Describe of surface corner Point of diversion.
(g) State number and kinds of animals to be watered none contemplated.

be as nearly continuous as weather will permit, when completed.
(h) Use will begin about Month and end about Month, of each year.

(i) Remarks It is intended to develop this water by tunnel and wells, and to erect a concrete penstock that will serve as watering place for range stock, if any in district, and to divert from the penstock by pipe line to points of intended use at mine camp located in Lot 9, being in the N.E. 1/4 of Sec. 21 Twp. 21 N.R. 23 E., and to be carried from there to the location of proposed mill in the N.E. 1/4 of Sec. 28 on Lot 1, of said section, township and range.

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED WORKS

Propose building a concrete dam or low penstock of concrete to catch the water of the various springs above proposed point of diversion, and from this penstock or pond created in this way, will divert through a pipe-line not to exceed a three inch pipe, to points of intended use at mine camp and at mill proposed to be built.

- 5. Estimated cost of works. There will be probably 1-1/2 miles of pipe line and approximately 200 feet fall in the distance of 1 mile: cost approximately \$5,000.00.
6. Estimated time required to construct works will probably require about two years to complete works and divert water into use.
7. Remarks This water is desired for the development and operation of the mining property in Section 21, Twp. 21 N., R. 23 E., and adjacent grounds, and for milling purposes, the mill to be located on Lot 1, Section 28, Twp. 21 N.; R. 23 E.
