APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to all existing rights on the source. A substantial measuring device must be installed to facilitate the measurement of water. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 1.0 cubic feet per second, and not to exceed a yearly duty of 4 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before May 23, 1951

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before June 23, 1951

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before May 23, 1952

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before June 23, 1952

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before May 23, 1954

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use must be filed with State Engineer on or before June 23, 1954

Proof of commencement of work filed JUN 25 1951
