It is proposed to further clean out the springs and build a reservoir, State manner in which water is to be diverted, whether by dam or other works, whether through pipes, ditches, flumes, or other conduits. If water or reservoirs, as stockwatering needs demand. is to be stored in reservoirs, it should be so stated and the location of the reservoir should be given with reference to the legal subdivisions.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: This permit is issued subject to all existing rights on the source. It is understood that the amount of water herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the period of use and the average number of cattle served from the waters of this source. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times but does not take responsibility for the use of the Federal range.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.0124 cubic feet per second, or sufficient water to water 400 head of cattle.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before July 5, 1971

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before August 5, 1971

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before July 5, 1972

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before August 5, 1972

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before July 5, 1973

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use must be filed with State Engineer on or before August 5, 1973
