The undersigned F. E. Bush and F. H. Murphey
of Cedarville, County of Modoc,
State of California, hereby make application for
permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as
hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation, give date and place
of incorporation.)

- 1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Onion Lake and
tributaries including flood and drainage water.
2. The amount of water applied for is 0.50 second-feet.
3. The water to be used for Stockwatering and domestic purposes.
4. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point:
In the SE 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 20, T. 43 N., R. 26 E., M.D.B.&M.

IF WATER IS TO BE USED FOR POWER, MINING, STOCK WATERING, OR OTHER USE, SUPPLY THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- (g) State number and kinds of animals to be watered 2000 head of
cattle and 8000 head of sheep.

- (h) Use will begin about Jan. 1 and end about Dec. 31, of each year.

(i) Remarks Applicants and their predecessors in interest have used this
source and the range territory for a considerable distance around same for
many years prior to 1905, and such vested rights which have been initiated
thereby, and which are claimed, are not waived by virtue of the filing of
this application. This means is taken to perfect a record right to the use
of said water, there being no provision of law at the present time for
the determination of vested rights for stockwatering purposes.

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED WORKS

A cut or trench will be constructed at the point of diversion to State manner in which water is to be diverted, whether by dam or other works, whether through pipes, ditches, flumes, or other conduits. If water facilitate storage and use of water for stockwatering purposes, is to be stored in reservoirs, it should be so stated and the location of the reservoir should be given with reference to the legal subdivisions.

5. Estimated cost of works \$200.00

6. Estimated time required to construct works Two years

7. Remarks The drainage from this Lake is toward the Bush and Murphey ranch holdings on Knott Creek.
