The undersigned W. W. Hughes, Pres, Farm Bureau Community Center Organization of Mesquite, County of Clark, State of Nevada, hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation.)

- 1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Mica Notch Spring
2. The amount of water applied for is .75 second-feet.
3. The water to be used for Culinary or domestic purposes
4. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point: Within SE 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 9, T. 15 S., R. 71 E., Mt. Diablo B. & M., S. 10° 30' W., 30,770 ft. from c.c. of Tps. 38-39 N. R. 16 W. G. & S.R.M. on Nevada-Arizona Bdy. Line.



DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED WORKS

Water of the spring is collected by means of a short tunnel and then conveyed to a concrete box from which the E.C.W. 2 inch O.D. pipe con-

is to be stored in reservoirs, it should be so stated and the location of the reservoir should be given with reference to the legal subdivisions. ducts the water to the 10,000 gallon storage tank at the end of said 2 inch pipe line located at point described as being S14°35'W 5808 feet from the same closing corner of Townships 38 and 39 North of Range 16 West, Gila and Salt River on the Nevada-Arizona State Day-Line from this point it is to be conveyed by pipe 15050 where the lines divide one to Bunkerville 16464 feet and to Mesquite 30075 feet.

- 5. Estimated cost of works including storage tanks \$40,000.00
6. Estimated time required to construct works two years
7. Remarks An effort is being made to secure the cooperation of the W.P.A. in building this much needed improvement for these two towns and the time required will depend upon the assistance obtained and also as to just how it is done.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to all prior rights. It is understood that the .75 cubic foot of water per second herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the amount of water actually placed to a beneficial use. It is further understood that accurate measurements of the water placed to a beneficial use must be included in the proof of such use when filed. The State reserves the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed .75 cubic feet per second.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before August 1, 1937

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before September 1, 1937

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before August 1, 1939

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before September 1, 1939

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before August 1, 1941. Proof of the application of water to beneficial

use must be filed with State Engineer on or before September 1, 1941


