The undersigned Stephen A. Bollinger
of Dayton, County of Lyon, State of Nevada, hereby makes application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation.)

- 1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Gold Canyon, near Dayton
2. The amount of water applied for is One and one half (1 1/2) second-feet.
3. The water to be used for Mining
4. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point: SE 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of Section 22, T. 16 N., R. 21 E., M.D.B.&M.

- (h) Use will begin about March and end about December, of each year.

(i) Remarks Applicant proposes to use water to conduct a gold dredging operation in Section 22 and recognizes the prior agricultural rights and agrees to by-pass water to satisfy said rights.

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED WORKS

Water will be diverted by a dam or sump in Gold Canyon and pumped up to Sec. 22 by an electrically driven centrifugal pump. An eight inch pipe line will be used.

- 5. Estimated cost of works \$5000.00
6. Estimated time required to construct works Six weeks starting Mar. 1, '38
7. Remarks The estimated total cost of the complete dredging plant is \$158,000.00 and the funds are being provided by an R.F.C. loan the first allotment of which is already approved. It is thought that actual production and use of water will not be reached until the spring of 1938.
