The undersigned John Dunsmore, E. S. Gillette and George W. Dunsmore
of Santa Monica, County of Los Angeles, State of California, hereby makes application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation.)

- 1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Whitney Well, (a driven well)
2. The amount of water applied for is one second-feet.
3. The water to be used for mining, milling and domestic purposes.
4. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point: in the NW 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 10, T. 14 S., R. 48 E., MDM., or at S. 53°30'E. 528' from the NW Cor., of said Sec. 10, unsurveyed, sections projected.

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED WORKS

Pumped directly from well, to the various places of use, through State manner in which water is to be diverted, whether by dam or other works, whether through pipes, ditches, flumes, or other conduits. If water approximately 10 250' of 2" iron pipe. is to be stored in reservoirs, it should be so stated and the location of the reservoir should be given with reference to the legal subdivisions.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to all prior rights on the source. It is understood that the one cubic foot of water per second herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the amount of water actually placed to a beneficial use. It is further understood that accurate measurements of the water placed to a beneficial use must be included in the proof of such use when filed. The State reserves the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed One (1.0) cubic feet per second.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before October 1, 1941

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before November 1, 1941

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1943

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before November 1, 1943

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before October 1, 1944. Proof of the application of water to beneficial use must be filed with State Engineer on or before November 1, 1944
