of Las Vegas, County of Clark, State of Nevada, hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation.)

- 1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Las Vegas Valley Artesian Basin
2. The amount of water applied for is one second-feet.
3. The water to be used for Irrigation and domestic purposes
4. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point: N. 19° 11' E., 1092 ft. from the SW corner of Section 23, T. 21 S., R. 61 E., M.D.B.&M., in the SW 1/4 SW 1/4 of said section 23.

IF THE WATER IS TO BE USED FOR IRRIGATION, SUPPLY THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- (a) Number of acres to be irrigated is 100
(b) Description of land to be irrigated S 1/2 S 1/2, Section 23, T. 21 S., R. 61 E.

- (c) Use will begin about Jan. 1 and end about Dec. 31, of each year.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to all prior rights on the source.

A valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste of water and accurate measurements of water placed to beneficial use must be taken from time to time. The State reserves the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed One (1.0) cubic feet per second.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before November 1, 1941

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before December 1, 1941

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before November 1, 1944

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before December 1, 1944

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before November 1, 1945. Proof of the application of water to beneficial use must be filed with State Engineer on or before December 1, 1945
