of Silver Peak, County of Esmeralda, State of Nevada, hereby make S application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation.)

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Upper and Lower Coyotte Springs

2. The amount of water applied for is one second-feet.
One second-foot equals 40 miners' inches

4. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point:

Upper Coyotte Spring in NW 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 14, T. 2 S., R. 38 E., MDM.
Lower Coyotte Spring in NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 14, T. 2 S., R. 38 E., MDM.

(i) Remarks Lower Coyotte Spring is the same water channel as the Upper Spring, and is plainly the overflow and drainage from the said Upper Spring.

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED WORKS

It is proposed to divert the water at the Upper Coyotte Spring, State manner in which water is to be diverted, whether by dam or other works, whether through pipes, ditches, flumes, or other conduits. If water from a sump, by gravity to the Lower Coyotte Spring through a 2" pipe line, a distance of approximately 1800' and thence pumped an additional 1800- feet to place of use with a total lift of about 150'.
