

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to all prior rights on the source. It is understood that the 0.022 of a cubic foot of water per second herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the amount of water actually placed to a beneficial use.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.022 of a cubic foot per second.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before July 1, 1942

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before August 1, 1942

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before July 1, 1945

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before August 1, 1945

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before July 1, 1946

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use must be filed with State Engineer on or before August 1, 1946
