The undersigned A. M. Elizalde, Name of applicant

of Beatty, County of Nye, State of Nevada, hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation.)

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Brick Yard Spring. Name of stream, lake, or other source

2. The amount of water applied for is one second-foot. One second-foot equals 40 miners' inches

3. The water to be used for mining and milling purposes. Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic, or other use

4. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point: From the NW 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 35, T. 2 S., R. 41 E., MDM. being S. 77° W., 4870' from the E 1/2 Cor., of said Sec. 35. Describe as being within a 40-acre subdivision of public survey, or by course and distance to a section corner. If on unsurveyed land, it should be so stated.

IF THE WATER IS TO BE USED FOR IRRIGATION, SUPPLY THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

(e) Works to be located in NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 6, T. 3 S., R. 42 E., MDM, being S. 77° E. 1700' from the NW Cor., of said Sec. 6. Give 40-acre subdivision on which works will be located, or locate by course and distance to a section-corner.
(f) Point of return of water to stream same as place of use. Describe in same manner as point of diversion.

(g) State number and kinds of animals to be watered

(h) Use will begin about Jan. 1st and end about Dec. 31st, of each year. Month Month

(i) Remarks: Full recognition is made of the prior stock watering rights of Chris Dahlstrom, and provision will be made at the said spring, that cattle may be watered.

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED WORKS

A shaft or tunnel is proposed to develop the flow of water, State manner in which water is to be diverted, whether by dam or other works, whether through pipes, ditches, flumes, or other conduits. If water which is to be conducted to the place of use, directly from is to be stored in reservoirs, it should be so stated and the location of the reservoir should be given with reference to the legal subdivisions. said shaft or tunnel, through approximately 13 510 feet of 3" iron pipe.
