hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation.) Incorporated under the laws of the State of Nevada,

(i) Remarks: this water has been developed by an open cut 3 1/2 feet wide, running about N 45 W 10 feet to a six foot face in a small canyon at the base of a rock wall about 20 feet high.

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED WORKS

At present only a small amount of water has been developed and the works to be installed will vary with the amount of water that can be developed.

State manner in which water is to be diverted, whether by dam or other works, whether through pipes, ditches, flumes, or other conduits. If water is to be stored in reservoirs, it should be so stated and the location of the reservoir should be given with reference to the legal subdivisions.

Unless an amount of water greater than at present now flowing can be developed a one or one and one-half inch pipe will be installed to carry the water to the camp and mine and proposed furnace situated in the NW 1/4 SE 1/4 section 31, T 12 N., R. 40 E., MDM.

5. Estimated cost of works at present about \$3,000.

6. Estimated time required to construct works 2 years

7. Remarks It is quite probable that water can be run by gravity to the mine passing the camp on the way, which camp will be lower than the mine.
