APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion and place of use of one cubic foot per second of the waters of Crystal Springs heretofore granted under Permit No. 10518 is issued to correct an erroneous description of the point of diversion and to change the place of use of water, and is issued with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein, and with the further understanding that there will be no actual physical change on the ground in the point of diversion from that represented by Permit No. 10518. It is understood that accurate measurements of the water placed to a beneficial use will be included in the proof of such use when filed. The State reserves the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The amount of water to be changed shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed One (1.0) cubic foot per second.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before January 28, 1944.

Proof of Commencement of Work shall be filed before February 28, 1944.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before January 28, 1946.

Proof of Completion of Work shall be filed before February 28, 1946.

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before January 28, 1947.

Proof of the Application of Water to Beneficial Use must be filed with the State Engineer on or before February 28, 1947.
