APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the place of use and manner of use of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit No. 11003 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit No. 11003 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. A substantial valve and weir or some other suitable measuring device must be installed at or near the point of diversion to facilitate the measurement and control of water. The State reserves the right to regulate the use of the water under this proposed change at any and all times.

The amount of water to be changed shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use and not to exceed 1.2 cubic feet per second.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before July 9, 1945.

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before August 9, 1945.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before July 9, 1946.

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before August 9, 1946.

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before July 9, 1947.

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use must be filed with the State Engineer on or before August 9, 1947.
